It was reported that the Board had decided to cancel the BBQ under the Covid-19 restrictions. The Commodore repeated the request that members with docks adjoining neighbours property be aware of respecting the neighbour's property.
- 4) **Vice Commodore** Bill Johnson reported for the Rear Commodore: Work on the north bank will proceed July 15. Channel dredging should take place at about the same time. There is an effort to install the Fairway Buoy however it requires a replicement anchor. Members with boats on the northside may want to consult with the Habour Master when work is being done.
- 5) **Harbour Masters South** Again thanks for cleanup help. With the high water there is consideration that it may be necessary to reinforce the blocks east of the south ramp.

 North Howard asked whether the river should be closed during the work on the North bank and the mouth. It was directed that the Secretary should give notice to members and that there should be signs placed on the gates.
- 6) **New business:** A question was raised by a member about the amount of work and the cost on the North bank. The length approved is 55 metres or roughly 180 linear feet. A rough cost was reported.
