1) Commodore's remarks

It was observed that a slate is missing on the south ramp dock. Action was referred to the Rear Commodore.

Rear Commodore: The township septic inspection has been completed. There were some roots inside the tank. The inspector recommended removing small poplar trees neat the tank. The clubhouse plumbing has been checked, no leaks. The door lock batteries were dead. They are now ready to be installed when the clubhouse is opened. The Fairway buoy is not out yet. The stanchions found on the south side will be painted to make them more obvious.

Fleet Captain: Given current Covid restrictions decisions are deferred on the normal BBQ on Civic Holiday weekend. A plan B was suggested of moving the event to the Labour Day weekend. Parry has offered to entertain.

Harbour Masters: South: Paul noted atat the location stakes are in. There have been quite a few new members. A list of locations for the south side has been sent to the website.
