Lake Huron Water Level

Water levels on all of the Great Lakes continued to decline during February. At the beginning of March, water levels on all lakes were well below their long-term average levels and much lower than they were last year. Water levels on all lakes, except Lake Superior, are also lower than they were at the same time during 2001. Lake Huron is 23 cm below last years level at this time.
