Notice on behalf of the Board of Directors

As per the recent directives of the Township of Huron-Kinloss, marinas (and their contractors) are now able to install docks. This will apply to the Pine River Boat Club. Public access to the property by vehicle is still not permitted and no launching of watercraft is permitted. Therefore the club gates will remain locked for the time being although Elliott Construction will be permitted to install docks. Hopefully the next step will be for the township to grant access to the river and the lake by lifting the State of Emergency. In the meantime, you may choose to personally install your dock without your vehicle.

Remember - Physical Distancing applies at all times.

From the Rear Commodore

On behalf of the Pine River Boat Club an emergency approval request has been sent to the Saugeen Valley Conservation Authority to temporarily repair the North river bank erosion issue.

The request was to continue in the same fashion as the work that was done this past fall. The SVCA has acknowledged our request, it is under review and we should hear back in the next week or so.

Elliott Construction has been put on standby to complete the temporary repairs upon approval.
