Despite the fact that the best two weeks of the summer were in September, it is my sad task to announce that the end of the boating season is near.

The club has been informed that, weather permitting, Elliott Construction will be removing the docks that members have contracted for removal about October 15. If you have made those arrangements you will want to have your dock ready to go before then.

If you are removing your own dock it should be out by the Thanksgiving weekend. If it will be in longer please make arrangements with the Harbour Master on your side. There should not be any stakes left that would pose a hazard.

All members are reminded to not leave anything on the property of the club neighbours. There are two places only that docks may be left over the winter. On the north side in the west parking area and on the south by the cement pad.

And now the sad news. The Fall General meeting passed an increase to the annual dues. This proposed increase appeared in the Spring newsletter, was noted at the Spring General meeting, duly moved, seconded and passed. The rationale was that despite a positive balance in 2017, the club had a negative balance for the four previous years. The initiation and social fees remain unchanged. The annual dues for 2018 will be two hundred fifty dollars (\$250). The late fee for payment after March 31 will remain at fifty dollars (\$50).
