



Pine River Boat Club Update May 17, 2021

In response to the rules regarding Covid-19 on April 27 the Board chose to leave the gates locked until they had further information. On May 16 by an email vote the Board chose to rescind that motion. The gate keys for paid up members are now activated.

The decision was taken based largely on the following information

- 1) we are not a marina or a municipal infrastructure but rather a private club that provides a ramp
- 2) Boat launch ramps are not required to be closed.
- 3) Boats may be placed in the water to be secured to a dock which suggests that docks may be installed.
- 4) Launching a boat is permitted for exercise or going for food which some suggest is the definition of successful fishing
- 5) Members would still be advised that they must refrain from public gatherings.

The Health Unit has not been in direct contact with the club providing instruction.
Should the Health Unit tell us that we must lock the gates that will be our immediate action.

Members are reminded that all Covid-19 restrictions and behaviors must be followed.

The clubhouse will remain locked.

Members who install their own docks may install them while following the province's restrictions. Elliott Construction will not be installing docks until some time after the Victoria Day weekend.

Members are reminded that at this time recreational boating is prohibited.

The Annual Spring General Meeting will be held on Sunday May 23 at 12:30 on Zoom. Members will receive a zoom link shortly.
